**STANDARD 1. Educational Quality Assurance Policy**

**Strengths:**

1. Well-developed international partnerships with leading universities and clinics in India, Europe, South Korea, and other countries.
2. The University participates in the QS ranking.

**Weaknesses:**

1. The University's Quality Management System (QMS) has not been certified.
2. Possible challenges in achieving the mission.

**Recommendations:**

1. Obtain certification of the University's QMS within two years.
2. By September 1, 2025, revise the mission statement to eliminate potential obstacles to its implementation.

**STANDARD 2. Educational Programme**

**Weaknesses:**

1. Insufficient work on the preparation and publication of the University's own teaching and methodological materials.
2. Insufficient use of research findings in the educational process.
3. The Department of Anatomy lacks plastinated anatomical specimens.

**Recommendations:**

1. By September 1, 2025, develop and implement a Plan for the preparation and publication of teaching and methodological materials, with annual analysis of results and subsequent corrective actions.
2. Within one year, develop an Action Plan to strengthen the use of research findings in the educational process, with annual monitoring of implementation.
3. Acquire plastinated anatomical specimens within one year.

### **STANDARD 3. Student-Centred Learning and Assessment of Student Educational Achievements**

#### **Strengths:**

1. Comfortable conditions have been created for students' learning, personal development, accommodation, and recreation.

#### **Weaknesses:**

1. Insufficient participation of students in scientific and educational activities.
2. Language barriers (Kyrgyz and Russian languages) hinder the development of clinical skills.
3. Insufficient involvement of faculty members in overcoming language barriers during students' communication with patients in clinical practice.

#### **Recommendations:**

1. Within one year, develop an Action Plan to increase student participation in international scientific and educational events, with annual updates and analysis of results.
2. Within two years, develop a multilingual phrasebook (English, Russian, and Kyrgyz) for student-patient communication.
3. By September 1, 2025, revise the internship programme and faculty responsibilities to address language barriers in student-patient communication during clinical practice.

### **STANDARD 4. Student Admission and Recognition of Learning Outcomes**

### **STANDARD 5. Academic and Support Staff**

#### **Weaknesses:**

1. The percentage of faculty members holding academic degrees in the field of medicine is below licensing requirements.
2. Insufficient number of international internships and training placements.
3. Insufficient publication of the University's own textbooks and teaching materials.

#### **Recommendations:**

1. Within two years, increase the percentage of faculty members holding academic degrees in medicine to meet licensing requirements.
2. Within one year, develop and implement an Action Plan for organizing international internships and training opportunities for faculty members, with annual analysis and corrective actions.
3. By September 1, 2025, revise the Plan for publishing textbooks and teaching materials to increase the number of internally developed publications.

## **STANDARD 6. Material, Technical and Information Resources**

### **Strengths:**

1. Modern and continuously upgraded material and technical infrastructure.
2. Well-developed and comfortable university infrastructure.

### **Weaknesses:**

1. Need to upgrade equipment in microbiology and biochemistry laboratories.
2. Insufficient number of subscriptions to international scientific resources.
3. Absence of the University's own clinical base.

### **Recommendations:**

1. Upgrade equipment in microbiology and biochemistry laboratories within two years.
2. Increase subscriptions to international scientific resources within one year.
3. Complete the construction and commissioning of the University's own clinic within one year.
