REGULATION ON THE RULES OF DECISION-MAKING ON THE ACCREDITATION OF EDUCATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS AND PROGRAMS

- Decisions on the accreditation of educational programs and organizations are made by the Accreditation Council (AC) at the Agency for the Accreditation of Educational Programs and Organizations (AAEPO). The regulatory framework for decision—making on national accreditation is Resolution No. 246 of the Kyrgyz Republic dated May 15, 2024 "Requirements and criteria for accreditation in the field of education", and on international accreditation - international norms and practices, Regulations on the Accreditation Council under the AAEPO and this Regulation.
- 2. Meetings of the AAEPO AC are convened by the Director of the AAEPO as necessary. Prior to the meeting, reports of expert commissions on the external evaluation of accredited educational programs or organizations are sent by e-mail to all members of the AU at the AAEPO. If necessary, heads of educational organizations may attend the meeting. Meetings can be held online.
- 3. The chairmen of the expert commissions are the speakers on the external evaluation of educational programs and organizations. In case of their absence, the speakers may be one of the members of the expert commission or the AAEPO referent who participated in the external evaluation process.
- 4. The AC under the AAEPO makes a decision on accreditation based on the discussion of the reports of the chairmen of the expert commissions.
- 5. The meeting of the AU under the AAEPO is conducted by its chairman, in the absence of the chairman of the AU, the meeting is conducted by his deputy. The Director of the AAEPO is a co-host of the Council meeting, however, does not participate in the voting. In the absence of the director, his deputy or adviser replaces him.
- 6. The accreditation decision is made by a simple majority of the votes of the members of the AU at the AAEPO. If the votes are equal, the chairman's vote is decisive.

- 7. The AAEPO AC decides on the international accreditation of higher medical educational programs and organizations based on criteria and standards agreed with the World Federation of Medical Education (WFME) and the rules of the AAEPO.
- 8. If all standards are fully met, the decision is made to "Accredit for 5 years", if 1 standard is not met, "Accredit for 3 years", if 2 standards are not met, "Accredit for 1 year", if more than 2 standards are not met, "Do not accredit".
- 9. With primary international accreditation (absence of graduates) the decision is made for a period of no more than 3 years.
- 10. If there is a written disagreement between the educational organization and the decision, the AC re-examines the accreditation case in accordance with the regulations on the AAEPO commission for the consideration of appeals and complaints. The decision is final and is not subject to further consideration.
- 11. Post-accreditation monitoring is carried out after one year with "1-year" accreditation, after 2 years with "3-year" and "5-year" accreditation. If there are grounds, post-credit monitoring may be carried out earlier than the above-mentioned dates.
 - In case of unsatisfactory results of post-accreditation monitoring, the agency informs NAC about this.
- 12. In case of international accreditation, in case of unsatisfactory results of post-accreditation monitoring, the AU has the right to warn, suspend or revoke accreditation. The deadline for correcting the comments of the commission on post-accreditation monitoring is set by the AC at the AAEPO, but not more than 6 months.
